What can you expect?

Our worship service happens each week, and we think of it as a Memorial Service to remember God and his Son Jesus. The worship service is about 1 hour long, from 11am - 12noon (ish). We sing, pray and read from the Bible. There are four songs or hymns, prayers and a typical sermon (we call it an exhortation) will last around 20 minutes. At the end, there are a few operational announcements.

Will I be singled out or asked to say anything?

No. You are free to be as anonymous as you'd like. Anyone who is asked to pray or read, is asked before the service starts.

What should I wear?

Whatever you are comfortable in. You'll see we are a diverse group. Most of us wear "business casual". Some of the women will be wearing scarves or hats.

What about the communion?

We call our communion by the very literal name 'breaking of bread' that Paul described Jesus doing. Jesus "took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said 'This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me". After someone is baptised, they are offered the bread and wine each Sunday.

What are Christadelphians?

Christadelphian means "brothers and sisters in Christ". We like the name because those who believed in Christ in Bible times also called each other brothers and sisters.

Will you ask me for money?

Towards the end in the operational section, there is an offering taken. Please do not feel obligated to give. Money collected contributes towards the hall rental and other expenses.
