God is our almighty creator and The Bible is his message to us. God will help those who truly seek him to be part of his eternal plan (John 17:3, Romans 10:13-14, 2 Tim 3:15, Hebrews 11:6).

GOD IS THE CREATOR

Creation around us abounds with evidence of design and purpose. It shows that our creator is powerful (Isaiah 40:28, Rev 4:11, Psalm 19:1-4), wise (Job 35:22-42:6) and almighty beyond our comprehension (Isaiah 40:12, Psalm 8:3-4).

It is God who gives us all things - even life itself and God wants us to know him (Isaiah 45:12, Acts 14:17, 17:24-28, Matt 6:25-34).

GOD CARES FOR US

God cares for us and all his creation (Psalm 104, 8:3-4). When we turn to God we can rely on his unfailing goodness and love (Psalm 103:6-18). God is our heavenly father and will provide for our needs (Matthew 6:25-34), and guide those who seek him (Heb 12:7-11).

GOD IS ALMIGHTY

God is all powerful. In the Bible God tells us that he is the one and only God and he alone is in control of everything (Isaiah 45:5-6, Eph 4:4-6, Deut 6:4). He is present everywhere by his spirit power (Psalm 139:6-10); he knows when a bird falls to the ground (Matt 10:29), the number of hairs on our heads (Luke 12:7) and even our thoughts (Psalm 139:1-4). Nothing is too hard for God (Psalm 62:11, 146:3-9, Isaiah 40:28).

God is eternal and has always existed. He created time and lives outside of it. (Psalm 90:2, 1 Tim 6:16).

When we pause to consider the enormity of such a God, it is beyond our understanding. God wants us to appreciate our position before him and come before him with reverence and respect (Job 38:1-7, 42:1-6, Isaiah 66:2).

GOD IS KIND, FORGIVING AND JUST

Just as God has freely given us all things, he wants us to be kind and generous to people in need (Matthew 25:31-46, Luke 10:25-37, Proverbs 14:31).

God will give justice to the oppressed and offers eternal life to those who come to him with sincere faith, extending the same love, mercy and forgiveness to others as he gives to us (Matthew 18:21-35, Psalm 103:6-18, Exodus 34:6-7, Galatians 5:19-23, Romans 2:6-8, 11:22, Micah 6:8).

GOD'S PLAN FOR US

God wants people who live by his ways to be part of his plan is for a worldwide kingdom of peace, plenty and righteousness. God's son, Jesus, will return to raise the dead and become king over a renewed earth (Jeremiah 31:34, Acts 1:11, Daniel 2:44, Hab 2:14, Matt 6:10).

God wants and calls each of us to be part of his coming kingdom. It's up to us how we respond (Luke 12:32, 2 Peter 3:9, Isaiah 45:22, 55:3-6, Acts 17:24-31, Matthew 22:1-14, Malachi 3:16-17).
